Interpreting standardized items presents unique and difficult challenges for classroom interpreters. Because no two interpreters will sign questions the same way, standardization of test presentation is at risk. This workshop will explore strategies for dissecting test questions and answer choices in order to ease the task of translating content into ASL. Some of these strategies include identifying patterns of question structures in English and utilizing patterns of signs order to reintroduce the concept standardization. Other strategies will utilizing basic ASL grammar structures such as Topic/Comment to clearly separate the components into a scenario followed by a question followed by answer choices. Participants will be asked to apply workshop strategies to a variety of grade level and subject matter test items and discuss their choices in small and large group settings. Participants will be given study resources for their own continued practice.
